Health Acquired Conditions (HR 3590, Sec. 2702)	The Secretary must identify the state practices applicable to the program that prohibit payment for health care acquired conditions, and for promulgating regulations prohibiting payments to states for expenditures on these health care acquired conditions, once they are identified.
